



LIMITED WARRANTY

FLUIDYNE High Performance (FHP) warrants its Direct-Fit Radiator Products to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the date of retail purchase from an Authorized Dealer by the original purchaser. This Limited Warranty is extended to the first purchaser of any such product only. Radiators repaired or altered by parties other than FHP and/or radiators that contain materials not manufactured by FHP, are excluded from this Limited Warranty.

Warranty claims will be limited to the repair or replacement of the defective part, at the sole discretion of FHP. The purchaser's remedy for breach of this Limited Warranty, exclusive of all other remedies provided by law, is expressly limited to the repair or replacement of any defective part.

The retail purchaser is responsible for the appropriate use and application of any FHP Direct-Fit Radiator Product. FHP radiators require a correct proportion of quality coolant which contains aluminum corrosion inhibitors. This Limited Warranty does not cover the effects of the physical or chemical properties of water, steam, or other liquids used in the radiator without adequate proportions of premium quality coolant.

Claims for damage of the engine and/or internal components, or user's vehicle are not covered by the FHP Limited Warranty. It is the responsibility of the FLUIDYNE radiator product user to monitor engine operation and have proper detection devices installed to warn the user of overheating. Specific exemptions for FHP radiators covered by this Limited Warranty include tube impact damage; tube ballooning; internal corrosion and/or any damage resulting from collision.

FLUIDYNE High Performance shall not be responsible for damages to its product or injury to persons using the product when improperly opening radiator pressure caps, burst hoses, etc. In addition, FHP shall not be responsible for injury or harm to persons or property caused by persons or vehicles using FHP radiator products.

Any FHP radiator product returned for warranty consideration must be returned to FHP with all transportation expenses prepaid. Upon receipt of the product, an FHP inspector will examine the radiator to determine the condition of the component, determine the validity of the claim and provide a disposition decision.

FHP radiators or other customer products which have been damaged in transit from FHP to the purchaser should be immediately reported to the shipper/carrier and claims for damage compensation to the purchaser filed accordingly. Do not return a product damaged in shipping/transit to FLUIDYNE High Performance.
